### Cities RISE event spruces up neighborhood

On a cool, crisp morning in September, 50 volunteers showed up to participate in our fourth Cities RISE community clean-up event. The group focused on sprucing up an area in south Elmira near "His Haven," who provided parking. More than 10 property owners were eligible for minor repairs to their front porches and yards. Volunteers of all ages painted, raked, weeded and

picked up trash throughout the neighborhood.

This project was in partnership with the City of Elmira, one of several New York municipalities that received grant funding for community revitalization projects as part of the statewide Cities RISE program.
